### **4:00pm Dancer Check-in**

- Arrive at KGMS, hair and makeup complete, 4pm.
- Dressing rooms will open at 4pm, and no earlier.
- A Sign-in sheet will be located in the side hallway by the dressing rooms.
- Once signed in, students will continue to the dressing rooms, and change into their first costume.
- Order of show will be posted on every door.
- No students are allowed onstage, backstage or in the audience unless given permission by Mrs. Emily Karlewicz
- Unless parent/guardian has volunteered to work backstage, parents will be dismissed to the Auditorium at 4:15pm. Experienced dance moms and teachers will be in dressing rooms to help!
- Dress Rehearsal will begin promptly at 4:30pm.

Rehearsal 4:30pm-8:30pm

- We will start rehearsal with bows, and then run the show in its entirety from the beginning.
- After a student has completed all their dances in the show, parents are permitted backstage to pick up their child and are dismissed for the evening.

### **Backstage Rules**

- Students will be allowed to watch the rehearsal from the audience.
- However, all students will have assigned seats in the audience. Student's MUST sit with their class.
- Backstage runners will be in charge of taking students from the audience to the backstage area and vice versa.
- Parents watching the rehearsal must sit behind all dancers.
- Volunteers stationed in the dressing rooms will help students change.
- Parents who have chosen to watch Act 1, 2 and 3 from the audience will not be allowed backstage until intermission, unless their student has finished all their dances.
- If you would like to stay with your child backstage, you MUST be signed up as a volunteer.
- If your child needs help changing during Intermission, you must go back stage and help them change. Volunteers will not be in charge of costume changes during Intermission.

### **Attendance**

- Attendance is mandatory. If a student does not attend the dress rehearsal, they will not be allowed to perform in the performances.
